



STUDENT AFFAIRS AND SERVICES

The University believes that much personal growth occurs outside as well as inside the classroom. Thus, it strives to provide an environment where student development can be encouraged through social, cultural, and recreational programs and services. Educational programs are designed to complement the more formal classroom instruction.

Orientation

A few days before the beginning of each semester all new full-time and part-time students are asked to attend an orientation program. This is designed to acquaint students with the rules and regulations of the University, to meet the faculty, administrators, and fellow students, and to facilitate the registration process.

Advisement, Counseling, and Placement Services

The University is concerned for students as individuals. Because they must make many decisions regarding their future, students at The University are given professional assistance in solving educational, vocational, social, and personal problems. Counselors assist students in evaluating their goals and aspirations. Students are encouraged to explore emerging interests, using the resources of the University to determine the career choices open to them.

In the natural course of development students may face crises of a personal, social, or economic nature. Students are encouraged to seek advice from the counseling staff. Similarly, counseling is available to those who encounter academic difficulties.

Student Government Association

All students belong to the Student Government Association. The officers of the Association are elected each Fall. The Association provides a channel for the communication of student opinion, concern, and interests. Each year the students plan a series of programs/events/activities to enhance the University experience for all.

Student Clubs

A number of clubs operate to cater to the interests of students. These currently include the debate club, drama club, literature club, poetry club, travel club, volleyball club, and the choir.

Housing

The University does not provide or supervise housing at this time. Assistance will be given to overseas students to locate appropriate housing on the island.
